

# WHAT DO I DO WITH MY GARBAGE?

Keep this helpful Transfer Station guide some place handy. This guide shows the proper procedures for disposal of your trash.

## DEMOLITION DEBRIS

**SHINGLES-TAR PAPER**-Must show permit from Lincoln's Code Enforcement Officer and place in demolition area.  
**SHEETROCK**-Place in the demolition area.

**WOOD**-i.e. brush, pallets, wooden furniture. **CLEAN WOOD ONLY. WOOD MUST BE FREE OF ANY METAL ATTACHMENTS.** Wood materials such as stumps and trees must not be larger than 4-1/2 feet long and 8 inches in diameter. Place in wood pit/burn area. We recommend you call ahead because you cannot dispose of wood waste on burning days.

## ACCEPTABLE WASTE

**ROPE**-i.e. polyester, cotton, twine, clothes line rope (not plastic coated) Place in burn pit.

**ROPE**- i.e. plastic or nylon—Must be cut into 3 foot lengths. Place in hopper.

## FLOORING & WALL INSULATION

(Includes rugs, backing and linoleum)-Must be cut into 3 foot squares. Place in hopper.

## ACCEPTABLE WASTE contd.

**PLASTICS**—i.e. tarps, PVC pipe, vinyl siding, garden hoses, swimming pool liners and any large pieces of plastic. Cut into 3 foot lengths or squares. Place in hopper.

**CANVAS**— Must be cut into 3 foot squares. Place in hopper.

**TIRES (RIMLESS ONLY)**- No tires can be deposited at the Transfer Station without a tire disposal permit. Tire fees can be paid at the Lincoln Town Office or the Transfer Station. Tire disposal fees are as follows:

Passenger/SUV/light truck/Utility.....\$ 1.00  
Medium/Heavy Truck.....\$ 8.00  
Equipment Tires.....\$ 25.00

Place all tires up to 17" in the hopper.  
Place all other rimless tires on the tire pile.  
(See Attendant for authorization)

**Freon-Charged Appliances:** Must obtain permit from Town Office. Call if unsure.

## UNACCEPTABLE WASTE

- **ASBESTOS**— Contact DEP or Code Enforcement Officer.

- **RIMMED TIRES**-To be acceptable, rims must be separated from tires.

- **CEMENT BLOCKS, BRICKS AND ROCKS**

- **GAS AND ANTIFREEZE**

- **DEAD ANIMALS**

- **MEDICAL WASTE**

## OTHER

**METAL**— i.e. all Freon-free appliances such as refrigerators and freezers, metal debris such as stoves, microwaves, hot water heaters, metal; sinks and tubs, and any/all other metal products. Place in metal pile.

**FURNITURE**-Place in furniture area. i.e. couches/stuffed chairs; mattresses go in hopper; **NO WOOD OR RUGS**

**PORCELAIN**-Place on recyclable porcelain pad. (See Attendant).

**BURNING SCHEDULE:**  
Please call ahead as burning is scheduled according to fire conditions

ITEM	RECYCLABLES	PREPARATION	NON-RECYCLABLES
NEWSPAPER	Newspaper with inserts, phone books, magazines, boxes-shoe/cereal/soda/food	Bundle flat	Wax-coated materials
CARDBOARD/BROWN PAPER BAGS (MANDATORY)	Clean cardboard, paper shopping bags	Remove all Styrofoam and packaging materials	Wax-coated cardboard
ALUMINUM & TIN CANS	Any can that contained food only	Rinse and remove all labels	Oil, paint or chemical cans
GLASS	Glass that contained food, dishware, porcelain, house window glass	Rinse and remove all labels	Motor Vehicle glass
PLASTIC	#1 & #2 clear and colored	Rinse	All other plastics
WASTE OIL	Crankcase, hydraulic, cooking oil	Keep free of water	Gasoline, solvents, antifreeze
COMPOST (CALL FOR FREE COMPOST)	Leaves, garden vegetables	Attendant must inspect before leaving	Food Waste, after cooked
MERCURY **Residential Customers Only	TVs, computers, fluorescent bulbs, ballasts, thermometers	Leave at mercury building & leave name with attendant	No commercial or industrial customers
